Page 3 Paragraph 3

Early on the morning of November 22, 1963 a small Cuban airplane landed at the Mexico City airport. The single occupant transferred to another plane that was waiting at the far end of the airport. It immediately took off for Dallas, Texas. Later that evening the plane returned from Dallas and the occupant transferred back to the Cuban airplane. After many months of checking and rechecking we are confident that the occupant was Fabian Escalante. One of the top aides to Fidel Castro. Escalante definitely had been identified in a flight from Havana to Mexico City in September, 1963.

Page 4 Paragraph 4

It is our belief he was sent by Castro to be an observer. We were aware that several Castro henchmen had infiltrated the United States via Mexico City and Florida. the first six to seven months of 63. Escalante worked closely with Raul Castro in espionage in South and Central America.
